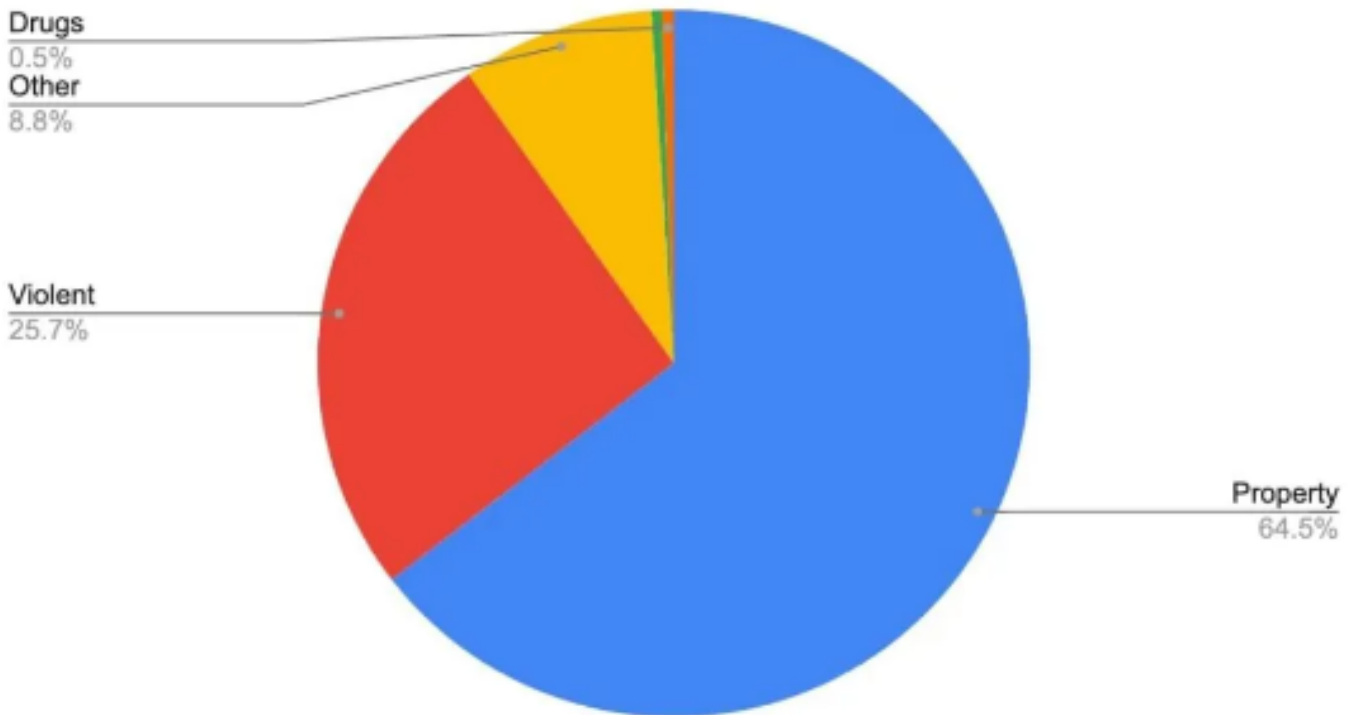
## Central Park

Central Park is an urban park located in the city center, with a population of 3,775. It has a high crime rate of 21,282 incidents per 100,000 people, which is three times higher than the city average.

There were over 1,095 reported crime incidents in 2022. Technically, about  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the population has experienced or reported a crime.

706 of the 1,095 reported crimes were property crimes involving mischief and motor vehicle thefts. 281 of the reported crimes were violent crimes, which consisted of assault and robbery.

### Reported Incidents



In 2021, Central Park also experienced its biggest crime frequency decrease, from 1,235 reported crimes in 2020 to 880.

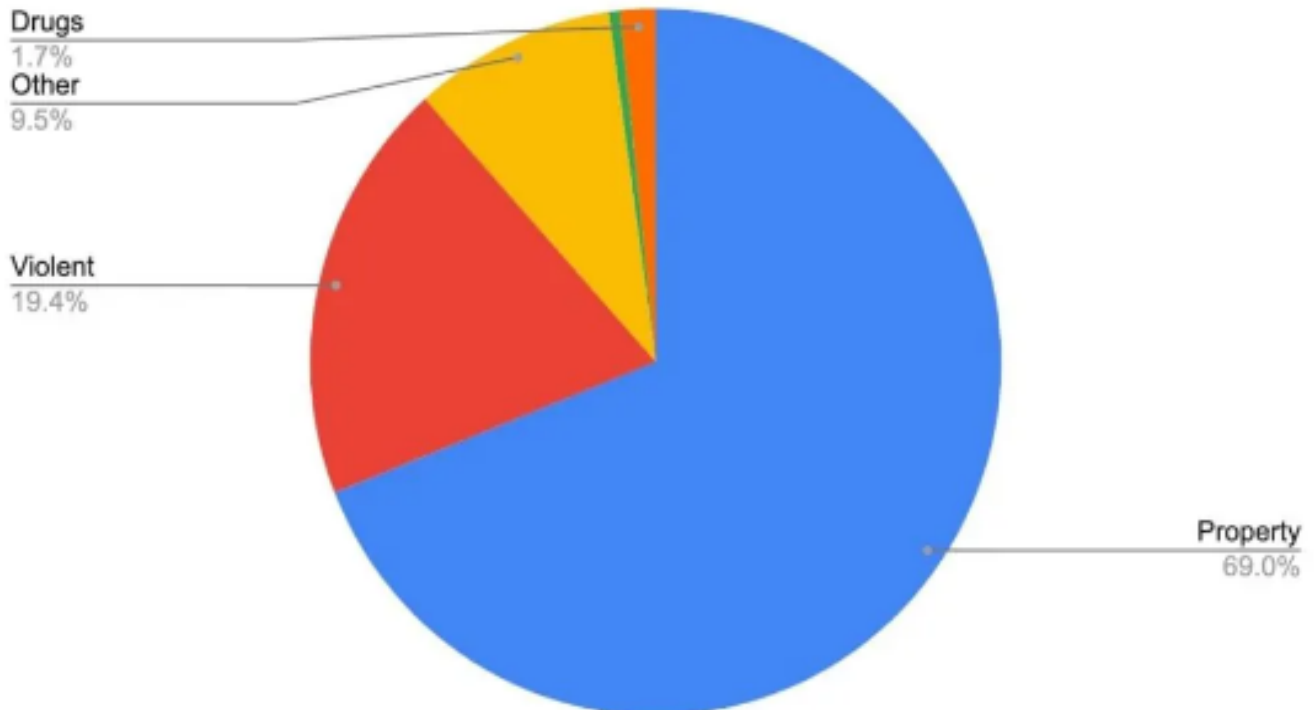
## Spence

Spence is located in the city center, beside South Portage. It is also known that Spence has one of the highest crime rates among most Downtown Winnipeg neighborhoods, with over 23,071 incidents per 100,000 people.

Spence had over 1,796 reported crime incidents in 2022, with 1,238 being property crimes like mischief and fraud, while 348 were violent crimes like assault and sexual assault.

Spence is also known for gun violence, with over 53 reported crime incidents.

### Reported Incidents



For the past four years, Spence's crime frequency has gone up, having the biggest increase from 2021 to 2022 of 29.49%.
